- 3. All matches will be played according to the U.S. Backgammon Federation Tournament Rules see http://usbgf.org/docs/rules.pdf Please familiarize yourself with the rules before the tournament.
- 4. This is a "Legal Moves" tournament. Any illegal play must be corrected if noticed by either player.
- 5. Dice that land flat on top of a checker are generally valid rolls. Sharing one pair of dice is preferred.
- 6. Byes and initial pairings will be randomly assigned by public draw.
- 7. Penalty points will be applied when a player is late for a scheduled start or resumption of a match.
- 8. All deposits are fully refundable until 9:00 AM on March 24, 2018. Only cash will be accepted at the tournament site.
- 8. The venue is a smoke-free facility.
- 9. Cell phones must be in silent mode throughout the tournament.
- 10. Pictures of positions are allowed, so long as it does not delay play. In clocked games, the photographer's clock must be running while taking the picture.

Main Event Descriptions Championship Bracket

Open to all. Single elimination, with progressive consolation and last chance. 11pt matches in Main Flight, 9pts in Consolation, & 5pts in Last Chance. Clocks are preferred at 2m/12s setting. Maximum of 64 entrants. 90% return Entry Fee, 100% return Side Pool.

Intermediate Bracket

Subject to eligibility determination, championship bracket players not permitted. 9pt matches in Main Flight, 7pts in Consolation, & 5pts in Last Chance. Clocks are optional at 2m/12s setting. Maximum of 64 entrants. 90% return Entry Fee, 100% return Side Pool.

Novice Bracket

Subject to eligibility determination. Exact format dependent on number of entrants, 5pt matches. 100% return.

Novice-No Cube Bracket

Subject to eligibility determination. Tournament without use of the doubling cube. Same rules as Novice Bracket, dependent on number of entrants. 100% return.

If necessary, the Novice and Novice-No Cube events may be combined.
